CHURCH COUNCIL MEETING
December 3, 2006

Council members of University Lutheran met Sunday after the service.

Pastor Dohrman opened the meeting with a prayer.

Jim Freeman and Bill Lueck moved and the council approved the minutes of the last meeting.

Jim Freeman distributed financial status reports for University Lutheran including the proposed budget for 2007.

Pastor was going to send Pastoral Reports to the District office.

Along with his property report, Rick Frazier mentioned that he and Meredith McKinney were planning to do some work at the church on December 20th.

Council decided that there would be one Advent vesper on December 6th, following a simple dinner. Council also decided that there would be only one service on Christmas Eve. It would be in the evening. (President's note: In actuality, a second service was added to the Christmas Eve schedule at 11 a.m.) It was also noted that there would be a party for students on the 8th, and a congregational Christmas party at Mary Hafner's on the 9th.

Elsa McKinney wanted to know what council's reaction was to the visit of Pastor Couch from Western Michigan University in November 2006. Council's reaction was very favorable.

Pastor mentioned again that he would retire in July 2007. Elsa asked for volunteers to a Pastoral Call Committee.

Resident issues such as job and work descriptions and upcoming vacancies were brought up. Pastor said that he would talk to the residents about all of this.

It was noted that LWML will grant us funds again to fund Peer Ministers for the next school year.

The meeting was adjourned, and Pastor sent council off with a blessing.
